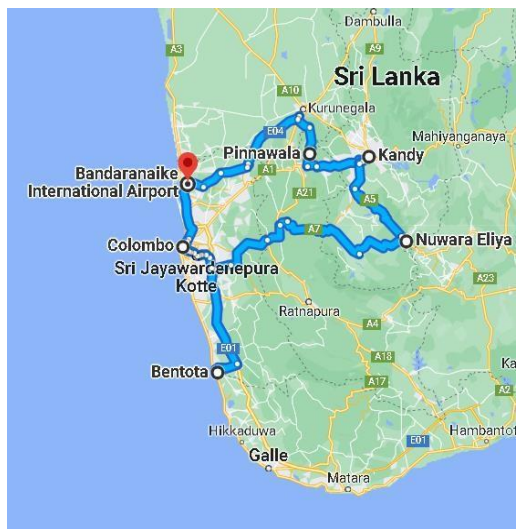

Day 01 –Airport / Kandy

Welcome & assistance at airport & transfer to Kandy

Kandy

Located in the foothills of the central highlands, Kandy, Sri Lanka's renowned second city is a beautiful city, surrounded by hills and valleys, rivers, lakes and cascading waterfalls. 129 Km away from Colombo Kandy, the charming hill capital, is the centre of Sri Lanka's rich culture and a World Heritage City or it may be said that Kandy is a perfect place to explore the unique history and the beautiful culture simultaneously. Popularly known as Maha Nuwara (means "The Great City") among most of Sri Lankans, Kandy is full of magnificent architecture displaying Indian and Sinhalese designs. It is a most sacred city for Buddhists with numerous temples and shrines, based on Buddhist architecture. Kandy was declared as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1988.

Day 02 –Kandy

Breakfast at the Hotel

Temple of the Tooth Relic – is a temple in the city of Kandy in Sri Lanka. It was built within the royal palace complex which houses the one of the two surviving relic of the tooth of Buddha, an object of veneration for Buddhists.



Royal Botanical gardens, Peradeniya which is well known for its large number and variety of plants, ornamental, Decorative, Useful & medicinal. More than 4000 species include indigenous and introduced plants. This garden is best known for its collection of orchids the largest in Asia.



Gem Museum/ Wood Carving / Batik Factory



The Cultural Dance Performance - This is a dance performance conducted by Traditional dancers and drummer of Sri Lanka. They perform various types of dance activities which are inheriting to different states of the country. This is a very colorful dance performance which you can enjoy the beat of Sri Lankan arts and culture.

DAY 03 - Trincomalee temple shakti peeth / Sigiriya

Break fast at the hotel & move to visit Trincomalee temple shakti peeth & sigiriya.

The Shankari Devi Temple is situated in Trincomalee on the eastern coast of Sri Lanka. While the original temple was destroyed many years ago, a new temple has been created next to the Koneswaram Shiva Temple.



Return back to hotel overnight stay.

Day 04 – Kandy / Nuwara Eliya

Transfer from Kandy to Nuwara Eliya

Visit Sri Baktha Hanuman Temple, Ramboda. The Ramboda area is believed to be an area where Rama's forces were gathered against Ravana. RamPadai means Rama's Force. The hills of Ramboda is also believed where Hanuman was searching for Sitadevi. The Chinmaya mission of Sri Lanka has built an Anjaneyar temple with Hanuman as the presiding deity. This temple is called Sri Baktha Hanuman temple and the image of lord Hanuman here is 16 Feet tall..

The service times at the Sri Baktha Hanuman Temple is between 7:00 am to 12:00 noon and again 3:30 to 6:30 p.m.

Visit Ramboda Falls





Tea Factory



Nuwara Eliya, the "city of lights," is the highest town in Sri Lanka and that means a break from the oppressive heat and humidity that surrounds the rest of the country. Situated at around 2000m above sea level and surrounded by lush tea plantations. Nuwara Eliya is the main hill resort of Sri Lanka and the heart of the tea industry. This city with an elevation of 6200 meters is the highest in Sri Lanka. Once a pleasure retreats of the European planters the town is still very much an English town with many English style bungalows and buildings.

Nuwara Eliya is a good escape for those who miss cool breeze in tropical Sri Lanka at any time of the year.



Visit Sitha Amman Temple

The Sitha Amman Temple can be seen en route to the Hakgala Botanical Gardens. The prominent temple architecture will not fail to attract your attention. Ancient statues of Rama and Sitha can be seen on one side of the temple. The temple today is a modern building with its paintings, statues and pillars decorated with sculptures; all depicting the tale of Rama and Sitha.

Day 05 – Nuwara Eliya / Bentota

Transfer from Nuwara Eliya to Bentota

Maadu Ganga flows across Balapitiya (approx 80kms down south of Colombo) and is one of the rarely visited, unspoiled attractions any nature lover can find in Sri Lanka. She boasts of having a cluster of 64 small islands scattered along her path and the most of which are covered with mangroves and uninhabited. The largest island is known as "Ma Doowa" is the largest inhabited island within the country where about 300 families live. The smallest islet of the lot is called "Satha Paha Doowa" where there is a tiny shrine with a statue built in respect of the gods of Kataragama.



Turtle Hatchery - In Kogoda, visit a Turtle Hatchery established to protect Sri Lanka's turtles from extinction. The hatchery pays fishermen for eggs that they collect at night along the sandy beach. Visitors can see huge tanks filled with new born turtle hatchlings. After being fed, the baby turtles are taken to the sea and released when they are 2-4 days old, usually during the safer hours of darkness. Although October to April is the main laying season, some eggs can be found at Kosgoda throughout the year.

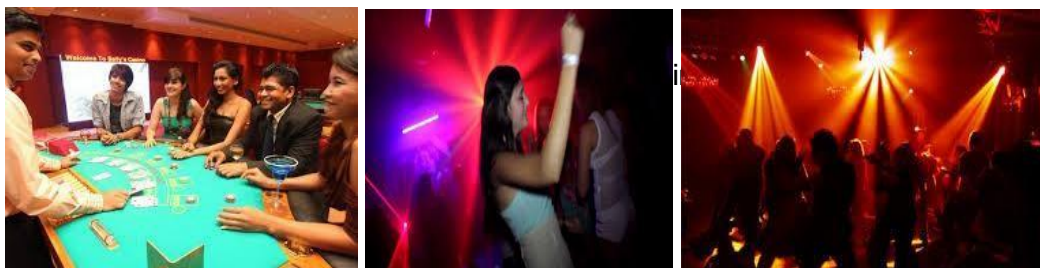
Day 06 – Bentota - Colombo

Colombo city tour – Colombo is the most vibrant city in Sri Lanka. During the city tour you will explore the historic, religious and commercial value of the city. This is a very small city and it is enriched with Colonial type of building and modern structured buildings. You will start your city tour from Fort area and Colombo National Museum. After that you will proceed towards Petta, the most happening bazaar area with mix of people in every nationality and religions. At the bazaar you can do some street shopping as well. There are many famous Buddhist temples, Hindu Kovils, Catholic Churches and Mosques. City tour will continue through Wolfe dhal Dutch church, Hulfts drop law courts and then to cinnamon gardens (high class living), Independent Square, Bandarayake International Conference Hall. Then you can do high end shopping and leading shopping malls in the city (Majestic city, ODEL, House of Fashion)



Colombo Night life – Being the capital of Sri Lanka, it is also its largest city and has the kind of *nightlife* in the five-star hotels, pubs, leading restaurants and clubs, Casino, Clubbing, Karaoke and ect..
